“Truly Swiss and truly international”, Le Régent International School is a 3-18 independent co-educational boarding and day school. Purpose-built as recently as 2015, Le Régent provides a multilingual, multicultural educational environment to over 160 students from over 35 countries.

The school is committed to holistic educational principles, combining a demanding academic curriculum with extensive sporting, arts and public-speaking programs.

The academic curriculum leads to IGCSEs in grade 10 and the International Baccalaureate diploma in grade 12. The language options are particularly strong, and many students speak at least two languages.

Located in Crans-Montana in the Valais canton, Le Régent’s outdoor education program comprising frequent expeditions, wild camping, ski-touring and cross-country skiing, takes full advantage of its stunning location to provide students with the personal skills and understanding of the environment that will serve them well in the future.

At the same time, Le Régent is proud of its commitment to contemporary pedagogy. It is an Apple Distinguished school and a large proportion of its faculty are accomplished and intelligent users of technology inside and outside the classroom.

Le Régent International School is an IB World School and an official examination centre for SATS, LAMDA, IELTS and Edexcel IGCSEs.

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CURRICULUM AND ACADEMIC REPORTING

Primary school and bilingual infant school follow an adapted version of the UK National Curriculum with a significant French input.

Classes 8 - 10

Students prepare and sit their IGCSEs.

IB 1 & IB 2

Students follow the IB Diploma Programme.

In addition, students have the opportunity to sit LAMDA exams, IELTS, SATs and ENGLISH EXAMS. Academic standards are high, as attested by 2020 IB, IGCSE and LAMDA results.

The transcript provides an overview of the students' academic profile taken from each of the three end-of-term reports and an end of year examination in IB 1. Grades are based on the IB 1-7 grading criteria.

As in many European systems, internal grades are a formative grade to indicate progress throughout the course, and therefore are not to be considered summative records of achievement at the time of grading.

Le Régent does not rank students, since they take a wide variety of courses with different combinations of Higher and Standard level.

All students sign an academic honesty contract at the start of their IBDP studies. Further to this, and in accordance with NACAC's Statement of Practice and Good Principles, Le Régent reports serious disciplinary infractions to colleges and universities, with particular attention paid to academic malpractice, to issues that could cause harm to individuals or the wider community, as well as to enrollment status.
